



Burnell Kenum Waldrep

Funeral service for Burnell (Keenum) Waldrep , age 84 , will be held Friday, May 20, at 2:00 pm at the Enon Baptist Church in Danville, Alabama, with the Rev. Tim Kenum, Rev. Mrs. Waldrep, who died Wednesday, May 18, 2016, at Decatur Morgan Hospital, was born July 27, 1931 in Lawrence County, Alabama to Charlie Kenum and Julia Mag (Bynum) Kenum.
