The family of Mrs. Elvie Mae Campbell Bolling, age 94, of Decatur, will host a memorial service at a later date. Her cremains will be interred in Barrancas National Cemetery, Pensacola, FL.

Mrs. Bolling passed away at USA Healthcare/Decatur Health & Rehabilitation, Decatur, AL, on Thursday, May 9, 2019. She was born in Jay, FL, to Laurence Washington Campbell and Cora M. Simmons Campbell. Mrs. Bolling grew up during the Great Depression, living primarily in Jay and Brewton, AL. In her lifetime, Mrs. Bolling immensely enjoyed being around youngsters, doting on her children, grandchildren, and especially her great-grandchildren. She also enjoyed her church family,

friends, the beach, quilting, jigsaw puzzles, and plants.

She was preceded in death by her husband, daughter, Janice Dockman, her parents, and sisters, Ellen Bole ware and Juanita Neese.
