Lois Jean Kuhn House, 94, passed away peacefully on Saturday morning, February 10, 2024 at her home surrounded by loved ones. She was born on January 7, 1930 to Frank Basil Kuhn and Pearl Means Kuhn in McAllen, Texas.

Mrs. House graduated from McAllen High School in 1947, where she was actively involved in the band, drama, cheerleading, and the student government association.
