



## Patricia Jeanne ""Pat"" Free

May 5, 1943 - July 25, 2015

Patricia "Pat" Sanders Free, age 72, passed away on Saturday, July 25, 2015, at her home in Decatur. Pat is survived by her husband of 50 years, Dewey Waylon Free; one son, Michael Alan Free and wife, Sherri, of Candor, NC; one daughter, Cynthia "Cindy" Ann Logan of Ladson, SC; one sister, Ann Heath of Decatur; and six grandchildren, Jonathan Free, Jessica Free, Jordyn Free, Benjamin Logan, Bethany Logan, and Lydia Logan.

Pat was born May 5, 1943, in Decatur. She graduated from Decatur High School in 1961. Following high school, she attended Bob Jones University.

Following college, she worked at the Army Missile Command Personnel Office, and then Wolverine Tube in the Personnel Office until she married.

She trusted Christ as her Savior at age seven while attending Vacation Bible School at Fairview Baptist Church of Decatur. She also was a substitute teacher in the church private Christian school.
