Randy Franklin Solomon, 70, of Decatur, Alabama, passed away peacefully at home on February 20, 2026. Born on August 23, 1955 in Ardmore, Alabama, Randy lived a life marked by humility, kindness, hard work, devotion, and love.

Growing up as the middle child, but oldest son of five siblings, Randy loved to spend time working on cars with his brothers and friends. 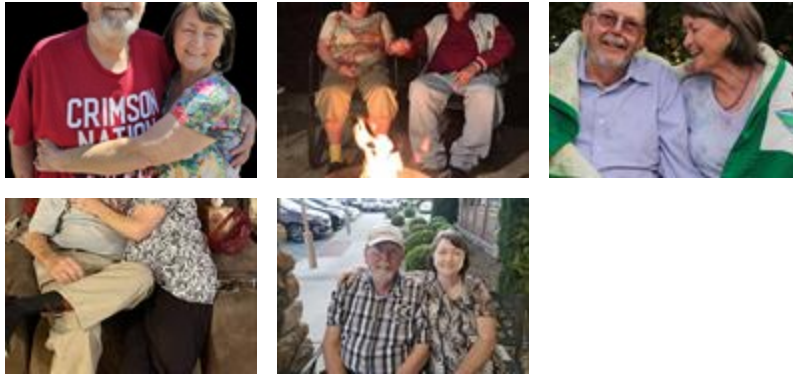
