Ronald Thomas Kusibab, passed away on November 4, 2016 in his home in Decatur, AL.

Ron was born October 15, 1942 and was raised in Detroit, MI. He graduated from Chadsey High School in Detroit in 1960. Shortly after high school he began three year stint in the Army serving in Korea. After being honorably discharged he moved back to Michigan where he began his career at Wolverine Tube, Inc. outside of Detroit, MI in 1965. He transferred to Decatur, AL with Wolverine in 1972 with the love of his life Kathy and first son Jeff, and three years later they had their second son Brandon.
