



Thomas Alfred Holloway, Sr.

Funeral service for Thomas Alfred Holloway, Sr., age 84, of Decatur, will be Thursday, June 28, 2018, 2:00 p.m. at Shelton Funeral Home Chapel with Bro. Joe Holmes and Becky Alexander officiating. The family will receive friends for two hours prior to service. Interment will be in Burningtrees Memorial Gardens.

Mr. Holloway, who died Tuesday, June 26, 2018, at his residence, was born February 15, 1934, in Gadsden, to Robert R. Holloway and Annie Miller Holloway. He retired from Champion Paper Company where he worked in maintenance, supervision, and training. Mr. Holloway was an accomplished pilot who owned two airplanes, and was an officer in the Civil Air Patrol for several years.
