



## William Lewis Key

Funeral service for William Lewis Key, age 82, formerly of Decatur, will be Wednesday, October 15, 2014, 11:00 a.m. at Shelton Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Dr. Jackie Kay officiating. Mr. Key, who died Sunday, October 12, 2014, at Glenview Health Care in Glasgow, KY, was born December 13, 1931, in Morgan County, to William Curtis Key and Sue Burt (Hill) Key. He was preceded in death by his parents, and one sister, Doris Key Flowers. Lewis received an honorable discharge from the U. S. Army in 1955, after serving during the Korean war.
